We will continue to encourage families to try and adhere to their allotted 10 minutes to try and prevent this happening in the future. We are continuing to improve this process and the next step is to provide parents with an opportunity to view their child's learning progress on their profile at a time convenient to them. In addition to this we also celebrate the learning that takes place both in and out with school and we love to hear about these learning opportunities from your children. We would now like to encourage children and their families to record their children's learning opportunities, experiences and achievements out with school into their child's electronic profile.

Our newly appointed digital leaders will run a short workshop for parents on Thursday 20th April at 9am and again at 2.45pm for any parent wanting to learn how to create an entry and upload information onto your child's profile. Details of how to access your child's profile and also how to add an entry will be issued at the start of next term.
